

## FROM SURVIVING THE STREETS TO SERVING NEIGHBORS

### Victoria's story of redemption

Seventeen. That's how old Victoria was when she used drugs and alcohol for the first time. But it wasn't the first time she saw them.

"My dad was in and out of prison. My mom was often drinking and partying," Victoria shares. From the loneliness from absent parents to horrific abuse when she was fourteen, the trauma Victoria carried ran deep. Since drinking and using drugs numbed the pain she felt inside, Victoria admits, "I loved to indulge, so I didn't have to feel what was happening."

### Sadly, the vicious cycle of addiction took Victoria to dark places.

"I lived in and out of garages, cars, even outside," she shares. "I've been on the streets half my life."

The sting of homelessness shocked Victoria to the point of seeking help. That's

when she turned to Carriage Town Ministries for the first time. But without the ability to stay clean and sober, Victoria would come and go. One time, we had to ask her to leave because of her severe intoxication.

"I understand," Victoria expresses. "I was a bother to the women. But it helped me see I really needed to get help, so I went to a recovery center."

Enduring alcohol detox was painful, but Victoria came through on the other side clean and sober. She was finally ready to finish what she started at Carriage Town Ministries!

In addition to graduating from our Personal Success Plan program, Victoria earned a job as a transitional worker at Carriage Town Bakery during her time here. And just recently, Victoria stepped out on faith and pursued a position as a Resident Coach in our women's program — and earned that, too!

Today, Victoria is shining with gratitude and peace! She has her own apartment, a job she loves, and two growing children who have their mommy to love and guide them. More good news: Victoria's mom has overcome addiction, too!

In addition to God and the staff here, Victoria wants to thank donors like you for your role in her redemption story!

"You may not realize all you're doing, but I do. It's a really good investment. I'm very grateful!"
